## Your Missionaries to Poland

### The McLane's Top 10 Needs List

Many of the churches we have visited have asked about our needs for Poland. We thought it would be good to include in this issue our most important necessities/requirements.

#### 10) Full Time Missionaries for Poland:

Currently there are 4 missionary families on the field in Poland. When we left for Poland in 2002, we were the only ones on the field at that time. This is a huge improvement and blessing for the field, however, we need more laborers as there are approximately 40 millions souls that need to receive Christ. **Are you Poland's next missionary?**

#### 9) Evangelism Teams:

We have opportunities in Poland to present the Gospel using youth, adult or mixed evangelism teams. **We need you!**

#### 8) English Teachers:

We need "native English speakers" to teach English in our Seminary in Warsaw as well as in other settings around Poland. This includes public schools, English Camps and churches with English schools. English has become a terrific method for evangelism. **Is God calling you to teach?**

#### 7) Speakers for Pastoral Conferences:

Many of our Polish Pastors are very young and inexperienced and our national leadership is looking for help in training and teaching its clergy. **Could you come short-term?**

#### 6) Mentors/teachers for Bible students:

A large number of our students in our Seminary and Extension Bible schools have been saved for only a very short time. We need Pastors and mature Christian leaders to invest their lives in our students through teaching, discipleship, and relationships. **Can you help?**

#### 5) Scholarships for Seminary Students:

In Poland a student can attend a secular school of higher education for free up until the age of 25. We have to charge our students tuition when they attend the Seminary because we do not receive government aid. Many of our young people who have the call of God on their lives do not have the money for Bible school. With unemployment being as high as 30% in some areas, most are unable to work to raise the money they need. We currently charge our students about \$1,500 USD per year for tuition and room and board. **Could you give \$25, \$50, or \$100 for tuition?**

#### 4) MAPS Teams:

Poland currently has 18 approved MAPS projects which include churches, Teen Challenge, and the Warsaw Theological Seminary. The future of the Polish church is very much dependent on the pastors and leaders that will be trained in the Seminary. We desperately need teams to finish these undertakings. **Can your church join us for 10 to 12 days?**

#### 3) Project Money:

Our Warsaw Seminary project will be completed as much as possible with MAPS teams. However, we need to purchase a boiler system and other items that must be put in with local licensed labor. We therefore need about \$100,000 USD to finish the project. **Please help us with this project!**

#### 2) Budget Support/Monthly Pledges:

We are now home on itineration trying to raise our budget so we can get back to Poland. We currently have about 61% of our budget raised. However, in order to return to Poland, our home where God has called us, we need to raise the remaining 39%. **Could you help us?**

#### 1) Prayer:

Our most important need is prayer. We covet your prayers. There has never been an Assembly of God missionary ever return to Poland for a second term. We must get back and we know that outside the budget that we need to raise it will take your prayers not only to get us back but keep us on the field. Please pray for continued vision, knowledge and understanding for us as we labor in Poland bringing in the Harvest.

We would like to voice our heartfelt thanks and appreciation to all of you who have spent time in prayer for Poland and the McLanes, as well as to you who have come to Poland on short-term missions trips, or have sacrificially given to keep us on the field. **THANK YOU!** We pray that God would richly bless you abundantly for your faithfulness.
